

# **Attachment A – Uniform Policy**

## **CALVARY CHRISTIAN SCHOOL DRESS CODE 2018-19**

Students are expected to be in full uniform upon ENTRANCE to school each day, Monday through Friday. The dress code is in effect from the first day of school through the last day. Personal cleanliness and neatness in dress and appearance are required at all times.

CCS uniforms may be purchased through Flynn & O'Hara (K-8) ([www.flynnohara.com](http://www.flynnohara.com)) or Lands' End (9-12) ([www.landsend.com](http://www.landsend.com)).

*School Administration reserves the right to determine what apparel is considered appropriate and consistent with the parameters outlined below, as well as, to take appropriate corrective measures to ensure compliance.*

### **BOYS AND GIRLS:**

#### **SHIRTS/TOPS (Solid Color):**

##### **Grades 9-12**

- Polo shirts or Oxford shirts (with Calvary logo) are mandatory.
- *Alternative:* Plain Oxford shirts may only be worn with a tie.

##### **Grades K-8**

- Polo shirts (with Calvary logo) are mandatory. Colors limited to white, navy, or burgundy

#### **OUTERWEAR (Optional):**

*Must be worn with a mandatory school uniform shirt underneath and must be a solid color with a) CCS logo or b) no words/images/logos.*

- CCS jackets or sweatshirts
- Zip-up sweatshirt or fleece jacket. Colors limited to navy, burgundy, gray, or black.
- Button down, crew neck, or V-necked sweater/cardigan. Colors limited to navy, burgundy, gray, or black.

### **BOYS:**

#### **PANTS (Black, Navy, or Khaki):**

- Chinos/Dockers with flat or pleated front pants, i.e. standard uniform pants (No jeans, athletic pants, or cargo pants)
- Walking shorts knee length (No jean shorts or cargo shorts)

### **GIRLS:**

#### **PANTS/SKIRTS (Black, Navy, or Khaki):**

- Chinos/Dockers with flat or pleated front pants, i.e. standard uniform pants (No jeans, leggings, athletic pants, or cargo pants)
- Walking shorts knee length (No jean shorts or cargo shorts)
- Capri pants (No jeans or cargo pants)

- \*Skirts should be no shorter than 4" from the middle of the knee and MUST be worn with shorts.

**Note (Grades K-3):** Plaid, khaki, or navy jumpers with Peter Pan collar are permitted, with solid color leggings or shorts

**Note (Grades 4-5):** Plaid 'kilts' are permitted, with solid color leggings or shorts

**Note (Grades K-5):** Uniform 'skorts' are permitted

*\*Note: Skirts rolled at the waistband or skirts/pants with cut off or slit hems are not permitted. Any notable infraction regarding skirt length may result in the loss of the privilege for the remainder of the school year.*

### **BOYS AND GIRLS: Additional Requirements**

#### **HAIR:**

Boys: No extreme styles as determined by the School Administration, such as less than a #1 shave cut, a Mohawk cut, long hair in eyes, or unusually spiked or colored hair. Hair should be no longer than one inch from the shoulder.

Girls: No extreme styles or unusually colored hair.

**SHOES:** Any footwear is acceptable except open toed shoes, shoes with higher than a 1" heel, slippers, and shoes deemed inappropriate for school wear by faculty.

**BODY WEAR:** Boys: No piercings, visible tattoos, or skin decorations.

Girls: Limit of two ear piercings with modest earrings. No other piercings or visible tattoos. No skin decorations.

#### **OUTERWEAR/ACCESSORIES:**

Items such as hats, sunglasses, and other decorative outerwear are not to be worn during the school day.

### **"CASUAL DRESS" DAYS: (when officially declared by School Administration)**

Students may wear jeans, athletic pants, dresses, or skirts (while still adhering to the length requirement) along with any Calvary team shirts, jackets, or sweaters. Students may also wear any solid color sweatshirt with a small non-CCS logo on the chest. **\*No skinny jeans, leggings, jeggings or tights are permitted.**

*NOTE: Dress Down privileges may be awarded to students with administrative approval throughout the school year. Students should not strain the bounds of modesty on those days (I Timothy 2:9, Romans 12)*
